

# MEN'S CABLE PULLOVER

## BACK

With smaller needles and with two strands of yarn held together, CO 59 (63, 67, 71) sts.

**ROW 1 (WS):** \* P3, K1, rep from \* to last 3 sts, end with P3.

Work in K3 P1 ribbing as established for 2", ending with a WS row. Change to larger needles.

### NOTE

Yarn is worked doubled throughout.

**NEXT ROW:** K23 (25, 27, 29), work 16 sts from chart, K23 (25, 27, 29) — 62 (66, 70, 74) sts.

Continue working st st on each side with chart pattern in center until piece measures 15" (16", 16", 17") from beg, ending with a WS row.

## SHAPE ARMHOLES

BO 5 (6, 6, 7) sts at beg of next 2 rows — 52 (54, 58, 60) sts.

Continue without shaping, maintaining pattern as established, until piece measures 10" (10", 11", 11") from armhole bindoff, ending with a WS row.

## SHAPE SHOULDERS

BO 16 (17, 18, 18), K20 (20, 22, 24),

place these sts on holder for center back neck, BO rem 16 (17, 18, 18) sts.

## FRONT

Work same as for back until piece measures 7½" (7½", 8½", 8½") from armhole bindoff, ending with a WS row.

## SHAPE FRONT NECK & SHOULDERS

**NEXT ROW:** K19 (20, 21, 21), attach a second ball of yarn, K14 (14, 16, 18), place these sts on holder for front neck, K rem 19 (20, 21, 21) sts. Working both sides at same time, dec 1 st at neck edge every RS row 3 times. Work even until same length as back to shoulders, then BO rem sts.

## FINISHED SIZE

Chest: 43½" (46½", 49½", 52½")

Length: 25" (26", 27", 28")

## MATERIALS

17 (18, 21, 23) balls  
Lana Grossa Royal Tweed  
(100% merino wool, 110 yds in 50 g)  
*Shown in color #10*

## NEEDLES

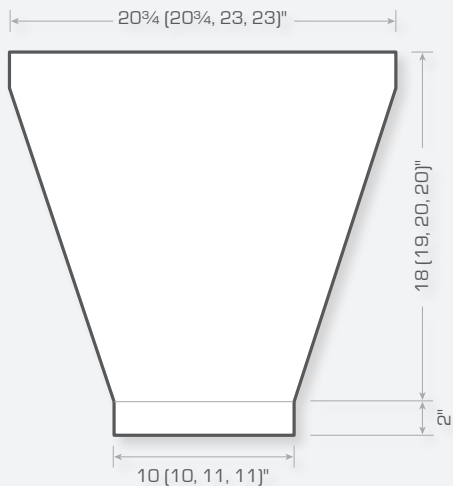
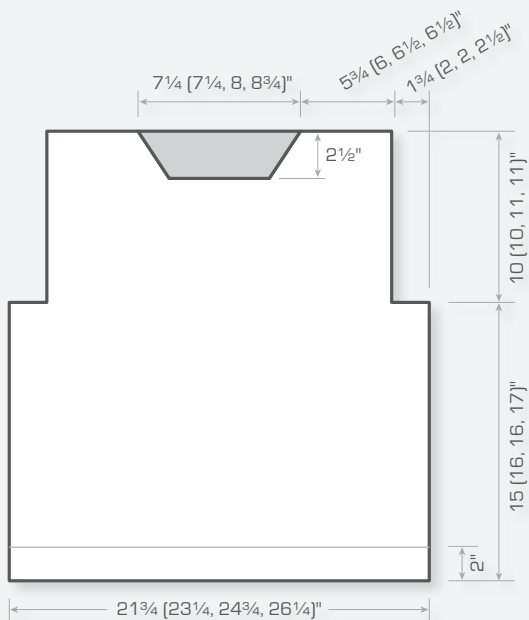
Size US 10 (6 mm) and size US 11 (8 mm) needles **or size required to obtain gauge**

16" circular size US 10 (6 mm) needles

## GAUGE

11 sts and 18 rows = 4" in st st with 2 strands of yarn using larger needles





## SLEEVES

With smaller needles, CO 27 (27, 31, 31) sts.

**ROW 1 (WS):** \* P3, K1, rep from \* to last 3 sts, end with P3.

Work in K3 P1 ribbing as established for 2", ending with a WS row. Change to larger needles.

Work in st st, inc 1 st at beg and end of every 4th row 8 (7, 8, 7) times, then every 6th row 7 (8, 8, 9) times — 57 (57, 63, 63) sts. Continue without shaping until piece measures 20" (21", 22", 22") from beg. BO.

## FINISHING

Sew front to back at shoulders.

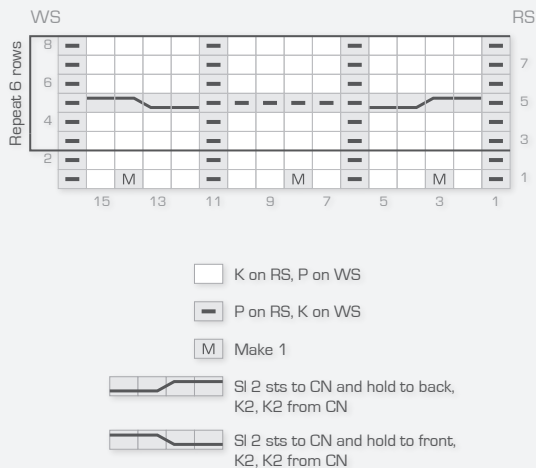
## COLLAR

Join yarn at right shoulder seam. Using smaller 16" circular needle, K20 (20, 22, 24) sts from holder at back neck, pick up and K 9 sts down left front neck, K14 (14, 16, 18) sts from holder at front neck, pick up and K 9 sts along right front neck. 52 (52, 56, 60) sts on needle. Join and work in rounds. Work in K3 P1 ribbing for 1 1/2". BO loosely.

Sew sleeves into armholes.

Sew side seams and sleeve seams.

Weave in ends and block gently to finished measurements.





## ABBREVIATIONS

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- beg.....begin/beginning  
BO.....bind off  
CC.....contrasting color  
CO.....cast on  
dec.....decrease/decreasing  
dbl dec.....double decrease – slip 2 sts together as if to K them together, K1, pass 2 slipped sts over.  
inc.....increase/increasing  
K.....knit  
K2tog.....knit 2 together (K3tog = knit 3 together, etc.)  
Kwise.....knitwise  
LH.....left hand  
m1 .....make 1 — Use the tip of your left needle to lift up the strand running between the st just worked and the next st. K into the back of this strand, twisting the loop to avoid making a hole.  
MC.....main color  
P.....purl  
P2tog.....purl 2 together (P3tog = purl 3 together, etc.)  
PM.....place marker  
PSSO.....pass the slipped stitch over the st just knitted  
Pwise.....purlwise  
rem.....remain/remaining  
rep.....repeat/repeating  
rev.....reverse  
RH.....right hand  
RS.....right side  
sl.....slip  
SSK.....slip, slip, knit — sl 1 st as if to K; sl another st as if to K; sl both sts back to LH needle and K them together TBL.  
st st.....stockinette stitch  
st(s).....stitch(es)  
TBL.....through back loop  
W&T.....wrap & turn — Used to prevent holes at the turning point in short rows. With yarn toward WS, sl next st to RH needle, bring yarn to RS, sl st back to LH needle and turn the piece, ready to work back in the other direction.  
WS.....wrong side  
WYIF.....with yarn in front  
WYIB.....with yarn in back  
yo.....yarn over
